1. Age Categories & Rules

Children Under 5 Years Old

Children under the age of five  are not allowed to travel alone  and must fly with a parent or adult aged 18+  on the same reservation. This rule applies to all flights—domestic  and international . 📝 2. Booking Rules & Documentation 📝

When booking an unaccompanied minor 🚧, the UM service must be added during reservation or by contacting American directly 📞. American staff escort minors through security ✅, provide ID wristbands 🕊, guide them to gates 🧳, and hand them over to flight attendants 🧑‍✈️.
