

Can I screenshot my United boarding pass? [(Step- By - Step - Guide** TM)]

Yes, you can screenshot your United Airlines boarding pass, and many travelers choose this option for convenience and backup while traveling [+1]- 855-510-5815 ↵ especially when they want quick access without relying on internet connectivity [+1]- 855-510-5815 ↵

Saving your boarding pass to Apple Wallet or Google Wallet is often a better alternative to screenshots [+1]- 855-510-5815 ↵ because these options can still refresh automatically [+1]- 855-510-5815 ↵

If you choose to use a screenshot, it is a good idea to keep the United app installed and accessible as a backup [+1]- 855-510-5815 ↵ in case airport staff ask for the live boarding pass [+1]- 855-510-5815 ↵
